Summer 2022 Grant Writing Group

The second annual Summer Grant Writing Group, lead by Carol Hammer and Ann Rivet, will begin Tuesday, May 24, 2022 and will meet via Zoom every 2 weeks thereafter, ending on Tuesday, August 2, 2022. The group is open to all tenure-track/tenured faculty, professors of practice, and research professors. All grant writers are encouraged to participate.

The aims of the group are to create a community of grant writers and to provide faculty with the on-going opportunities to discuss and receive feedback as they

Announcements from Offices Supporting Research@TC

Institutional Review Board (IRB)

All research staff on an [Institutional Review Board](#) protocol must have an updated Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative ([CITI](#)) [Certificate](#) (within the last three years) [filed in Mentor IRB/PI Documentation](#). If your CITI training is expiring, please take the IRB Social and Behavioral Researchers refresher course located in your CITI program profile on [CITI's website](#). If the refresher course is not available, contact Dr. Myra Luna-Lucero, Research Compliance Director at IRB@tc.edu or call 212-678-4105 to request access to the CITI refresher course. Office of Sponsored Programs (OSP)

The staff of OSP are ready to support faculty as they work on their applications for funding and would like to assist faculty early in the process. Please share any RFA with your [sponsored program administrator](#) as soon as you decide to apply. Also, faculty are reminded that all applications for grants and contracts need to be routed through OSP and that all paperwork, with the exception of the narrative, need to be provided at least 5-business days prior to the due date. Additionally, any agreement for funding must be signed by the Provost. Faculty do not have the legal authority to enter TC into an agreement.

Office of the Vice Dean for Research (VDR)

In addition to the Summer Grant Writing Group and the Internal Funding Opportunities, the Office of the VDR has added the following supports for the faculty. First, the Faculty Research Advisory Committee, consisting of a member from each academic department, has been established. The Committee, which will hold its first meeting on March 31st, will provide feedback on all aspects of research at TC.

Second, we are testing an online database offered by [Academic Analytics](#) through the summer. Access to the robust dataset will facilitate our goal of

helping TC faculty identify potential funding opportunities and collaborators at TC, across Columbia, and with external institutions. Only a handful of TC administrators have access to the database during this trial period. Therefore, the VDR is inviting faculty to fill out a “faculty expertise search form” to request a search for potential collaborators and/or grant opportunities. The form will be posted at the [Research@TC website](#) by April 4. Third, we have been strengthening our research ties to Columbia University through meetings with members of the CU Office of the Executive Vice President for Research. We are planning a networking event between TC and CU faculty to be held in Fall 2022. In preparation for this event, we will be collecting information from faculty on their collaborations with CU faculty. Stay tuned for a forthcoming brief survey.

Fourth, if you are considering applying for a large interdisciplinary grant or a training grant, please reach out to Carol at vdr@tc.columbia.edu to discuss possible supports that may be available.

Finally, Dr. Bryan Keller, Associate Professor of Practice in the Department of Human Development, has agreed to provide statistical consulting to faculty on manuscripts and grant applications. The **William T. Grant Scholars Program** supports early-career researchers in the social, behavioral, and health sciences. The program funds five-year research and mentoring plans that significantly expand researchers’ expertise and address one of our two research interests: studies to reduce inequality in the outcome of young people, or to improve the use of research evidence to benefit young people. Because early-career researchers are rarely given incentives or support to take measured risks in their work, the program offers a mentoring component and a supportive community.

serves as a catalyst for generating and supporting novel projects that improve the knowledge, training, or practice of mental health around the globe, especially in low-resource settings. Each award will provide a maximum of \$20,000 for one year. Open to early investigators committed to a research career relevant to global mental health. Applicants can have a Columbia appointment or, if not, must collaborate with a Columbia faculty member and submit the application in a multiple Principal Investigator (MPI) format.
