Discussion and Announcement redesign includes an updated UI and new features:

- Improved search with highlighting
- Edit History
- Flexible viewing options: Inline and split view
- Role Labels
- Quoting
- Reply Reporting and notifications to Instructors
- Full and partial anonymous graded discussions
- Sort options (Newest to Oldest, Oldest to Newest)
- Filtering (All, Unread, Read)

The "Manage Assign To" Feature

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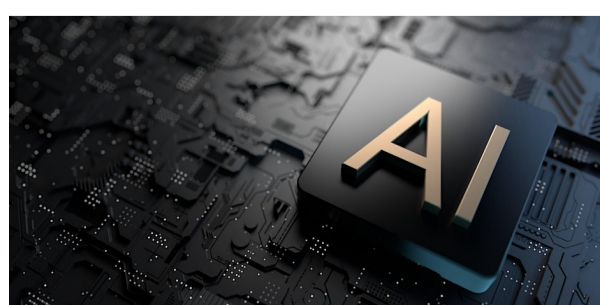
- The "Manage Assign To" link replaces the traditional location of the "Assign To" settings.
- Can be found in both [Assignments](#) and [Discussion Boards](#).
- Allows you to assign to specific people or everyone in the class.
- Allows you to add due dates and availability dates.
- If the "Manage Assign To" settings is ignored it will default to "Everyone" in the course, and will exclude due dates and availability dates.
