### 1. Coming Soon to your Canvas Course

#### Ally for Teachers College:

Ally is an integrated tool in Canvas that helps instructors enhance accessibility of digital content in their courses. Ally instantly [checks your Canvas course files](#) for common accessibility issues using a scoring system.

Ally then provides guidance and tips for improvements that will drastically increase the accessibility of your course content and creates [alternative formats for your files](#), such as audio files, screen readable PDFs, etc. Instructors can improve file accessibility with Ally's step-by-step instructions.

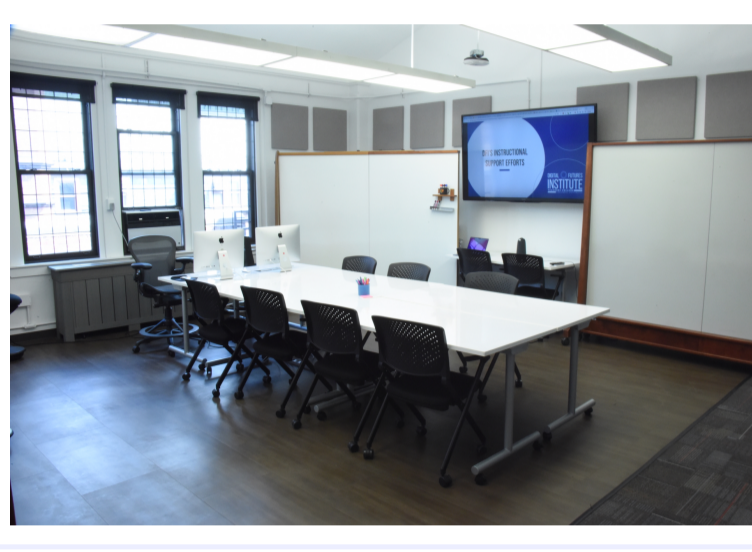

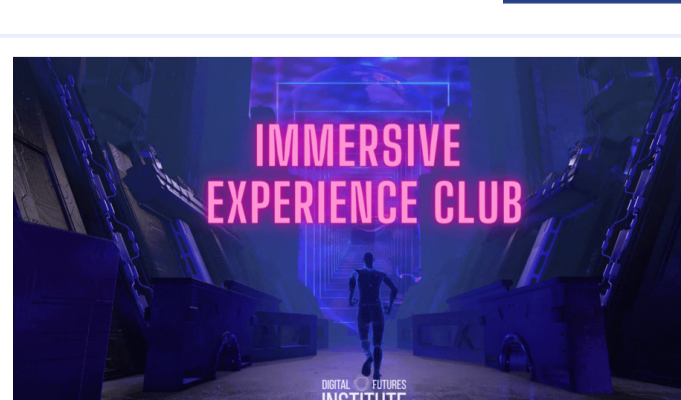
